Shortland Chambers COVID-19 Vaccination Policy (Levels 9-13 Shortland Chambers Building)

From 1 December 2021, Shortland Chambers required all visitors to have been fully vaccinated before entering Chambers.

We have now updated our policy so that from **23 April 2022**, only those people who have received two doses of the COVID-19 vaccine or have had a negative rapid antigen test within the prior 48 hours, will be able to come into our Chambers or attend Chambers events.

This policy is aimed at keeping our workspaces and those with whom we interact at Chambers protected as far as we are able from the risk of being exposed to COVID-19.

If you have not received two doses of the vaccine or returned a negative RAT test, we ask that you support our policy by communicating with us outside of Chambers, either via video call, phone, email or meeting offsite if needed.
